# About Laparoscopic Spay

# Pricing

Laparoscopic is another word for “keyhole surgery”. This modern technique has now been developed for use in animals. Our practice has invested in the latest equipment so that we can offer our patients this relatively new technique.

The standard method of spaying involves making a 10-15cm incision into the abdomen, from the bellybutton downward. Laparoscopic spaying uses just two small cuts, each approximately 1cm long.



A camera is inserted through one cut, and the instruments are inserted through the second cut. The camera magnifies the inside of your dog’s abdomen, allowing our surgeons to see the ovaries in excellent detail. The vessels connected to the ovaries are then sealed, and the ovaries removed.

### Less Pain:

This technique causes much less trauma to both internal and external tissues. This means less inflammation (swelling) and less pain during the recovery period.

### Quicker Recovery:

The smaller wounds and cut in the muscle means a quicker healing time. A reduced period of rest is needed after the surgery. Your dog can be back to her normal self, much quicker than using the traditional method of spaying.



Two days post-op

The cost of a laparoscopic spay is based on the weight of your dog at the time when she is spayed, as shown in the table below. The price includes the general anaesthetic, the procedure itself, pain relief for during and after the procedure, up to two post-op checks and a plastic cone. A medical jacket instead of a collar is an optional extra.
